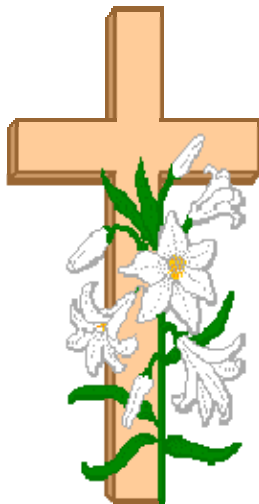

GOOD SHEPHERD ASSEMBLY MEETING MINUTES

02-Mar-10, Church of St. John the Baptist

1. Attendance
Faithful Pilot, SK Rick Jacobson reported that all in attendance were in possession of a current membership card. He also responded to the officer attendance as follows:

 - b. **Officers Absent:** Faithful Admiral, SK Bob Mathewson, Faithful Outer Sentinel, SK Bob Odash, Faithful 2nd Year Trustee, SK Jerry Reitter, Faithful 3rd Year Trustee, SK Jack Hunt. Faithful Friar Rev. Bernard Reiser.
2. Principles and Duties of the Order were reviewed. This was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and opening prayer.
3. The minutes of the February meeting were reviewed and approved as corrected.
4. SK Clyde Paul commented on the correct way to address the Navigator. One stands, makes a sign, makes comments, and addresses the Navigator.
5. Faithful Comptroller, SK Robert Peltier distributed the report, and it was approved.
6. Faithful Purser, SK Steven Frank gave his report, and he pointed to a problem of balancing the meal costs with the amount taken in. A motion to raise the meal fee to \$15 was defeated as was a motion to raise the meal price to \$14. The price will stay at \$12 for the rest of this year, and the new administration will address the problem this summer.
7. The following people applied for 4th Degree and were approved: Brian Gostanzik and Richard Vana.
8. Pictures will be taken at the April meeting, and these pictures will be included on our Web Site. All members are encouraged to attend in their formal attire.
9. Under Council reports, it was reported that the new St. Charles council has fifty plus members, and is doing very well.
10. Guard Commander, SK Clyde Paul, reported on upcoming honor guards. We should take special note of a Knights of Columbus event which will take place at Target Field on August 22. There will be a Mass followed by a ball game.
11. The Annual Golf Fund Raiser is coming up on June 14. The cost is \$80 per person.

15. Sir Knight, Orlin Wicks presented the idea of developing a brochure to promote the Good Shepherd Assembly. SK Marc Peters agree to take on this project as his schedule permits.
16. Conclusion: Review of symbols of the Order followed by the singing of the National Anthem and a Closing Prayer.
